- April 10, 2008 – Most recent General Meeting was held at Stone Creek Dining Company in Plainfield, IN. Topic was the Indiana Tie Card Project and presented by Lorraine Wright with IDEM.
- May 14, 2008 - Meeting was held for selections of both Vincennes University and Purdue CIC scholarships. Chapter had planned to award \$2000 to recipient of each school. One recipient was chosen for Vincennes University. However, in the case of Purdue, we only received two applicants and both were felt close enough to merit a split with the awarded amount between the two. Those two will each receive \$1000. All recipients have yet to be notified of the selections.
